- ▶ Our weekly and fortnightly liner services connect all 14 major ports across the country.
- We offer various container types of varying sizes for all types of cargo. Our 6,000 TEU owned container fleet includes refrigerated and dry containers.

- ▶ We provide short and long-term vessel charters, to the shores and rivers of Papua New Guinea and the wider Pacific Region.
- Our team of experts understand the complexities around moving cargo, heavy lift, hazardous goods, break bulk and more, allowing customers to reach any local market in Papua New Guinea.
- We are also experts in river shipping in PNG with shallow draft tugs and landing craft vessels suitable for operation on the Purari and Fly rivers.

GENERAL TRANSPORT

 We offer a wide spectrum of ISO accredited land transport services including containerised cargo, bulk, and break-bulk cargoes with a fleet of over 100 transport assets all across PNG.

BULK FUEL TRANSPORT

With over 50 fuel tankers we supply contracted bulk fuel delivery services to major energy companies all across PNG covering aviation fuel, marine fuel, diesel and unleaded petrol.

CUSTOMS CLEARANCE

• We have in-house customs clearance teams embedded into our container transport operations with EastWest Transport in both Port Moresby and Lae.

DEPOT & WAREHOUSING SERVICES

We have over 50 ha of depots across the country with depots, manpower and machinery to manage storage needs on behalf of customers or dedicated space for customers to self-manage.

Consort Express Lines, Pacific Towing, JV Port Services and EastWest Transport (the four operating companies that comprise the logistics division) have all independently attained ISO certifications 9001 - Quality, 14001 -Environmental, 45001 - Occupational Health & Safety.

SOLAS COMPLIANT

Pacific Towing and Consort Express Lines (our two marine entities) as required by the SOLAS convention, Chapter IX (Management of Safe Operation of Ships), comply with the ISM Code which requires the development and use of a Safety Management System (SMS) on board all vessels. Our SMS is periodically audited by Lloyds Register (LR) to maintain our Certificate of Compliance.

STEAMSHIPS

CONVENIENTLY **SITUATED PORTSIDE BUSINESS PARK**

Steamships possesses 38 hectares of land at its Portside Business Park facility which is adjacent to the PNG Ports wharves at Motukea. PNG Port's facility receives all Port Moresby international liner shipping vessels and is also well-suited to cater to international bulk, project and other specialist vessels with its four berths with 11m draft within its ISPS secured facility.

Steamships' businesses operate from this location with Consort Express Lines calling into PNG Port's domestic wharf, JV Port Services (as Motukea United Limited a landowner Joint Venture) loading and discharging Consort vessels and non-liner international vessels, Pacific Towing offering towage and mooring services and JV Hire Company offering heavy cargo handling machinery for short or long term hire. With EastWest Transport's yard and workshop just 4km down the road towards town offering fuel transport, general transport, and customs services Steamships is able to offer the full suite of logistics support services at this site.

The Portside facility is ideally suited for laydown and storage needs, either in secure depots or in warehouses. It's the ideal cargo staging point for inbound international cargo on its way to either Herd Base up the Purari River or the LNG Plant 20km down the coast at Caution Bay. Steamships can offer the handling and transport equipment (land and marine) to move cargo on to its final destination.




Steamships is a firm believer in sustainable development, 'development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs'.
